



Prayer Diary: 13TH - 19TH October

"Honour the LORD with your wealth and with the first fruits of all your produce"

Proverbs 3:9

Monday Give thanks to God for the land we live in. Give thanks to God for our varied seasons and weather which yields good harvest and plenty of food for our nation. Pray for those who do not live with such bounty. Ask God to remind us daily of His goodness and to lift our eyes to the beauty of His creation all around.

Tuesday Pray for those for whom weather and climate make the difference between feast or famine. Reflect on the climate changes, and fires, land slides, floods and drought which affect families, livelihoods and whole communities. Ask God to remind us of our responsibilities to care for others and our earth and to take care of all He has provided through reflection on food waste, overbuying or sharing meals with others.

Wednesday Pray for farmers around the world who toil to provide a living for their families. Bring to mind the story of Ruth and what we can learn from it. Reflect on God's will that we should be just and merciful, and pray that exploitation in this industry would be revealed and mitigated. Pray for fair wages for workers, for good, sustainable stewardship of land, and integrity among multinational supermarkets.

Thursday Lord, we pray for those around the world who are desperate about providing food for their families. Help us to look at your people with the compassion of Jesus. "Today, the world stands on the brink of unprecedented famines. About 30 million people are experiencing alarming hunger, severe levels of food insecurity and malnutrition in north-eastern Nigeria, South Sudan, Somalia, and Yemen.10 million of them are facing emergency and famine conditions." (Oxfam international)

Friday Pray for politicians and governments around the world. We have heard about using food as a weapon of war and about exploitation and corruption, and we feel overwhelmed by crises we read about. Pause to think about the poor and oppressed, and wrestle with the challenge of loving our neighbour. Ask God's forgiveness when we have turned our eyes away or hardened our hearts.

Saturday We give thanks for all those who help to alleviate the problem of hunger in our community. We pray for the work of Community Fridge and CAP here at VBC and for all the voluntary organisations, such as Foodbank, around our town. We pray, too for the ministry of the bakery in Lebedyn and for the work of providing food in the orphanages in Ukraine. Ask God to bless their work as they serve others and to give impact to their campaigning, interceding and fund-raising.

Sunday

As we pray "Give **us** today our daily bread. "help us to understand the issues of hunger for others, make '**us'** the people around the world who are starving. Ask our Father in heaven to feed us on His Word today, to prompt us into action by His Holy Spirit, and to strengthen us spiritually in our walk with Jesus.

James 2:15-16 "Suppose a brother or a sister is without clothes and daily food. If one of you says to them, " Go in peace: keep warm and well fed," but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it?
