One of the staggering features of the British Columbian coastline is the somewhat bizarre and grotesque sea wall that has been formed by giant tree bodies of

Canadian pine being piled high by gigantic Pacific rollers during

windstorms.

These massive trees, cut down by lumberjacks many miles inland, have floated down the Canadian rivers and having been parked in huge floating compounds to await careful and skilful attention by the saw mills, have slipped the boom, and in a new

found freedom have floated many miles to the open sea, there to be scuffed by the rocks and impregnated by the sand so

that now, useless and decaying, they lie like coffins in a graveyard, having missed completely the purpose for which they were felled.

God, in His infinite wisdom, has created mankind in His own image and has given him certain guidelines wherein he can find a freedom that will satisfy himself and bring pleasure to the Almighty - guidelines wherein he can lead a life of commitment, purpose and fulfilment, at the



end of which there will be no regrets and an acknowledgement that life has really been worth living.

Alas, many today have slipped the boom and in a new found freedom outside the



Will of God, have found their lives wrecked on the stormtossed oceans of life, so that now, like wasted pines, they prepare to write their own epitaph of wasted years, seemingly beyond any hope of salvage.

But God, like an Omnipotent Coastguard still mans his rescue station and any call, no matter how trivial or desperate, brings immediate response. No S.O.S. to Jesus ever went unanswered!

Prayer Diary: 15th - 21st August

(based on Psalm 37)

Monday Do not fret because of those who are evil or be envious of those who do wrong for like the grass they will soon wither, like green plants they will soon die away." God is revealing much that is evil in these days when the rich get richer and the opposite happens to those financially struggling. As we see this happening, let us ask God to help us **not to fret but to pray** – for those in need to have their genuine needs met. Let us pray for all those involved in provisions like food banks and our community fridge events etc. Let us also pray that those who "will soon wither" might have an encounter with Jesus as Saviour and Lord so they genuinely give to those in need.

Tuesday "Trust in the LORD and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture." As we are experiencing this period without rain, let us seek God's guidance so we have His help to save water where possible, as we pray for rain to water the land. Farmers need 'safe pasture' just now, more than any of us. Let us pray for farmers who are most desperate for rain to save existing crops, and those whose livelihoods are dependent on the sowing of winter crops just now. As we non-farmers seek to "do good", can we support farmers by getting provisions direct from them? Pray that we will all be guided how we can do good to assist our brothers and sisters in these times.

Wednesday "Commit your way to the LORD; trust in Him and He will do this. He will make your righteous reward shine like the dawn, your vindication like the noonday sun." Praise God that He shines light on our paths and is willing to guide us day by day. Let us pray for all those struggling to see the way forward in their particular circumstances, and also those for whom circumstances are changing - children starting school soon; those changing schools or going to university; or those older ones moving into residential care. All need God's help and guidance on the 'way' forward. May all who believe in Jesus, 'shine like the dawn' in His righteousness as their way leads them onward - young and older alike.

Thursday "Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for Him; do not fret when people succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes." As we come before our heavenly Father to pray, let us have a few moments of stillness to just enjoy Him. Then, as we pray, let us uphold our brothers and sisters in Lebedyn for whom this verse seems so appropriate. Let us uphold all Christians, also in Ukraine, seeking to serve their communities. Also, pray for our persecuted brethren around the world. About 70,000 Christians were killed for their faith in Nigeria in 2020, and many in other countries too.

Friday "Refrain from anger and turn from wrath; do not fret - it leads only to evil" We are also told in Ephesians 4:26 - "In your anger do not sin. Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry." This verse in Psalm 37 gives us the reason why - "it leads only to evil." In these days when evil appears to be flaunted in our faces, and is applauded so often in the media, there is much for Christians to be angry about. Our Father God has broad shoulders - so share with Him all those things that make you angry and ask for Him to show you if there is anything He would want you to actively work to change, thanking Him that He knows about it, and can be trusted to repay and resolve evil in His time - which may not be our timing!


Saturday "For those who are evil will be destroyed, but those who hope in the LORD will inherit the land." Genesis 50:24 Then Joseph said to his brothers, "I am about to die. But God will surely come to your aid and take you up out of this land to the land He promised on oath to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob." Let us praise God who keeps His promises and oaths. We can praise Him that the prophecies about the Jews returning to the Land He gave them are coming true, so we can look forward to Jesus' return. Let us praise God that Jewish and Arabic peoples in Israel now have a Bible college where they study the Bible together. Let us thank God too, that a group of Jewish and Arabic believers are producing New Testaments online, and in print; making these available in Israel for the first time. We can also pray for all the congregations where Jews, Arabs and Gentiles worship together. May God create unity as cultural norms are swept out of the way, and grant His blessing.

Sunday Hebrews 3: "See to it, brothers and sisters, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God. But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called "Today," so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness". We can thank our trustworthy God who is "The Truth" in these chaotic days where everything is being shaken, including the Church. As we see 'sin's deceitfulness' abounding and being put centre stage, let us ask God to show us any deceitfulness in our own hearts, so we can repent of any sin or unbelief; and then we can pray for any brothers and sisters who are struggling with such things, praying they will stay close to Abba. Pray none of us turn away from our "Living God" in these testing times.
