# Prayer Diary 15<sup>TH</sup> - 21<sup>ST</sup> January

"There are different ways of serving but the same Lord is served. There are different abilities to perform service, but the same God gives ability to everyone for their particular service". 1 Corinthians 12: 5-6

**Monday** *"she opens her arms to the poor and extends her hands to the needy" Proverbs 31:20* Pray for all who work in the caring professions within the NHS, our local Hospice, the various residential and care homes and all who visit as carers. Pray, too, for the work done by PARCHE. With a change in the weather, pray for those aiding the homeless and destitute.

**Tuesday** *"Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord."* Ephesians 6:7 There are many who serve our fellowship "behind the scenes" whose service can often go unnoticed or taken for granted. Give thanks for our caretaker, Kevin, and for those who maintain and keep an eye on our properties. Give thanks for the many who exercise a prayer ministry and pray that all of us will be able to fulfil our God-given tasks.

**Wednesday** "Carry each other's burdens and in this way, you will fulfil the law of Christ" Galatians 6:2. Uphold the work of our Life Groups as they minister to the needs of their members. Remember those now unable to attend a group regularly through frailty, advancing years or because of parental responsibilities or work patterns. Give thanks for modern means of keeping in touch by text, e-mail or phone to maintain these vital links. **Thursday** "Be faithful unto death and receive your crown of life" Revelation 2:10. Remember the service offered by those working to support and encourage the increasing number who are in the final lap of their earthly race. Pray especially for those with dementia, those with a terminal illness and for those with the need to depend on the support of others. Remember those who care for loved ones at home.

**Friday** *"It was He who gave gifts to mankind … to prepare all God's people for the work of Christian service …"Ephesians 4:12.* Pray for all who have been given responsibility for the building up of God's people here at VBC - those who preach/teach on Sundays; those in children's and youth work; those who disciple new Christians through Alpha; those who minister in practical ways through our CAP and Community Fridge.

**Saturday** *"We are partners working together for God, and you are God's field" 1 Corinthians 16:11.* This week includes the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. We were sad to receive the following e-mail earlier this week, from Nigel Foster. Stan's funeral will be held at Basingstoke Crematorium on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> Feb.

## Dear Friends at Victoria

I am writing to let you know that my Dad, Stan Foster, passed away yesterday (8<sup>th</sup> Jan) after a short illness...he was 91. He was able to live in his flat at Lady Susan Court in Basingstoke until the last few days, when following a fall he was transferred to a palliative care bed at Alton Community Hospital, where he died. I had the privilege of being with him when he went to be with our Lord Jesus.



He only had a small family (I am his only child), but he also had two granddaughters (both now married, with a first great granddaughter due in May). We are all Christians so it's wonderful for us to know he is now in a "better place"!

Stan worshipped at Victoria from 1971 until moving to be close to us in Basingstoke in 2019, and for many years he served as one of your organists. I'm not sure how many of the fellowship will know and remember Stan, but Victoria Baptist had a very special place in his heart, and I know he read with interest the news and magazines that you sent through to him.
