

#### LIVING IN THE GOODNESS OF GOD



Eddie Lyle is President of Open Doors UK and Ireland but comes to us today in his capacity as Trustee of Hope Lebedyn and as their Ambassador at Large - not in his Open Doors capacity. Eddie is a respected Bible Teacher and passionate advocate for the persecuted church. His vision is to see every church in the UK on its knees in prayer and on its feet in action in support of its persecuted family. He is married to Christine and they have a son, Adam.

Eddie will speak about Living in the Goodness of God. He will explore Psalm 23:5 as if he were speaking to Christians in Ukraine who are living through the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the war. His talk will also seek to draw out the lifestyle lessons that our brothers and sisters can teach us through the example of their courageous faith, and how this bible verse speaks to us today in Eastbourne.



## Prayer Diary 19<sup>TH</sup> - 25<sup>TH</sup> February

"The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective." James 5:16

As the second anniversary of the war in Ukraine approaches next Saturday (24<sup>th</sup>), our focus this week will be on our sister church and mission centre in Lebedyn.

#### Monday The Team and the Centre

Please pray for individual members of the team - Pastor Bohdan and Pastor Sergey, and Alla and the children; Farmer Sergey, Valentin and Luba (youth work), Svetlana (children's work and young mums), musical Sergey, and his wife Lyuda, who has health issues, Victor (site manager) and Sasha (ICT). Pray that issues about being conscripted into the army will be resolved. Pray too for continued protection over the facilities, including the cars and minibus they use.

#### **Tuesday Family Life**

Pray protection over the minds of the young people and children experiencing the trauma of war. Pray for their schooling, which so many have missed out on. Pray for strong internet so learning can be done remotely. Pray too, for wisdom in supporting the increasing numbers of refugees arriving in Lebedyn. Pray for the families who have lost loved ones or whose loved ones are away fighting.

#### Wednesday Children's and Youth Ministries

Please pray for safety from bombs and missiles so that all the ministries can take place. Pray for fun and friendship at the Friday and Sunday youth clubs. Pray for the leaders as they plan Easter and other holiday camps. Pray for the teenagers who are so keen to study God's word. Thank God for the amazing puppet ministry that has led so many children to know Jesus. Pray for wisdom in discipling new Christians in difficult circumstances, especially those who have had to flee with their parents and are no longer connected to the church.

#### **Thursday Other Ministries**

The church does such a lot to support the community. Please pray for safety as they seek to fulfil their mission to serve Jesus and the community. Pray for supplies of bread flour for the bakery and for the young mums who attend services and receive aid. Pray too, for the English classes, the seed distribution, computer classes, sewing ministry, hospital visitation and general aid distribution. Please pray for strength to continue these tiring ministries. Pray for energy, rest and enthusiasm.

#### Friday Individuals and partners of Hope Lebedyn

There are so many stories of God answering prayer and helping people, that there are too many to mention. But please pray for Dima, who is a prisoner of war missing for 18 months. Pray for his wife Luda. She wants news, she has heard nothing since last April. Pray for Vlada, a young woman who has serious mental health issues caused by war. She is close to giving her life to Christ. Something in her past is blocking her.

Pray for Pastor Andrew in Samatoivka right on the Russian border as he seeks to serve his village in extreme circumstances. Pray too, for Mission Eurasia as they seek to source aid from Europe, and also our partners in Germany sourcing aid. Pray that applications made to UK and US trusts will bring more financial support for the charity.

#### **Saturday Peace and World Leaders**

Today is the anniversary of the war. Please pray for peace and for the wisdom needed to create peace. Pray for both the Russian and Ukraine governments and their leaders. Pray that international support will not dry up in the light of other conflicts. Pray that, in the long term, reconciliation will be possible and forgiveness will reign and not hatred.

#### Sunday Unity, Strength and Witness

As we worship today, pray for Eddie Lyle, President of Open Doors who is speaking at VBC.

Pray for unity between the Orthodox and Evangelical churches in Ukraine. At present there is mistrust as the Orthodox church is pro Russian. Pray for the health of the team so they may continue to serve. War weariness is a big issue. Pray for developing team spirit and a deeper relationship with Jesus as they serve Him. Pray for the board of trustees of Hope Lebedyn and all the supporters as they seek to raise awareness and funds to help the church in Lebedyn.
