prison and local people living in desperate circumstances in a pretty affluent part of Surrey, God broke my heart for what breaks His.

I saw then, and now I continue to see brokenness - yet every day I see glimpses of the kingdom yet to come through a combination of practical help, supportive church communities & the love of Jesus Christ.

Prayer Diary: 20TH - 26TH October

"If you are tired from carrying heavy burdens, come to me and I will give you rest. Take the yoke I give you. Put it on your shoulders and learn from me. I am gentle and humble, and you will find rest. This yoke is easy to bear, and this burden is light."

Matthew 11:28-30

Monday Lord, we pray for all those who are burdened by debt, worry about finances, are trapped by anxiety over where their next meal will come from and fear over eviction. Lord, for many people day to day struggles are overwhelming, and managing in our "affluent" society is confusing and chaotic. Lord, help us to see folk with compassion, concern and with the eyes of Jesus. Help us to reach out to those who seem to be beyond reach to all but You.

Tuesday Heavenly Father we pray for those we know and see here in Old Town who need support. For those who come to Community Fridge on Wednesdays and for the Christians Against Poverty clients. Lord, we give thanks for their courage to ask for help and ask that they may see relief from their burdens. We pray that, while some of their physical needs are met, they will come to see the Love of Jesus.

Wednesday Father God, we thank You for the services provided in Eastbourne to help others. We give thanks for the CAP debt centre here at Victoria. We pray for Phil, Nadine and the volunteers; sustain them, Father. Inspire them with words to say and what not to say or do. We pray the same for the workers at Foodbank, Matthew 25, Street Pastors, Beachy Head Chaplaincy and all the other supports around town.

Thursday When we look at our town and society Lord, we ask that Your love, faithfulness and compassion will prevail. We pray against addictions of all sorts and ask that people will be freed from these chains. Help us to stand against oppression and greed and disorganisation. Lord help us to see the victims in our world and to speak out against aggressive advertising, poor administration and inflated profits. Lord, use our voices to cry out in the darkness that many find themselves in and to proclaim that You are the Light of the World.

Friday Pray for the people behind the scenes of debt agencies, social services, schools, charities and policy making. Lift to God administrators, facilitators, government agencies, counsellors and trustees who work to alleviate the problem of hunger and poverty. Lord, we ask that support for the most vulnerable, due to illness, mental health issues, old age, lack of education or poor choices, will be forthcoming, and we ask for God's blessing on those who receive help. Pray that God will multiply the provision as He did for the hungry in Galilee.

Saturday Father God, as we look towards the winter months and Christmas we pray for those in need. We pray against the additional pressures parents feel, we ask for companionship for the lonely, we pray for warmth for homeless people, and provision for those who are worried about heating bills. Lord, we ask that the parcels and gifts we are proposing for this year will meet the needs of friends and will be a blessing. Help us to use the opportunities we have to spread the Good News of hope.


