

Last time we saw that the first person God provided to meet Jacob at the end of his

journey was Rachel, the love of his life. Love for Rachel would sustain Jacob through many years of hardship. The second person he met was a different kettle of fish.

Laban's appearance as a welcoming uncle hides a more sinister character. One Jewish commentator suggests that when Laban embraced Jacob he was patting him down to see if he had any gold! The last time a visitor had come from Beersheba, he'd arrived with ten camels. Laban thought he was welcoming a wealthy relative. When he realised Jacob was penniless, he changed his approach. Laban would get as much from Jacob, for as little as possible.



Through all this Jacob would see his own sins laid bare, and what he might have become but for God's intervention in his life. He'd also see that God was working out a plan to bless Jacob (and through him the world) in a most unexpected way.
