



# The Sermon on the Mount – The Good Life

"Blessed... Blessed..." (Matt. 5:3-5)

What do you think of when you think of the Good Life? If it's Richard Briers and Felicity Kendall you're giving your age away! What would it mean for you to be living the Good Life? What brings deep satisfaction, peace and a sense of well-being?

I guess some of us may think about sunshine and holidays or success at work and financial security. For others it's about good relationships and seeing our children prosper. For others it's taking the dog for a walk, swimming in the sea or going out for a meal with friends. I guess for our friends in Lebedyn it would be to live free from the threat hanging over them.



Jesus begins the Sermon on the Mount with nine statements beginning with the word 'Blessed'. We call them the beatitudes. This week we'll see that the first three turn his listeners' expectations of the Good Life upside down.



#### Urgent need!

Following the notice In the e-mail that accompanied last week's news sheet, and given the urgency of the matter, we thought we would repeat the message in this week's edition. As you read this, please think through what this is all about. Imagine Sunday mornings with no words on the screens and



for the sermon, and so on. Imagine no microphones being available at the front. Imagine not being able to record, and indeed transmit live, the services for people around the country and beyond. Perhaps an exaggeration but this is what this plea is all about - enabling God's Word to be broadcast and reaching out to those watching online. And of course, enabling those of us attending the service to see and hear without any difficulty.



#### Sound

We currently have 6 people who can do sound, but 3 of them also cover cameras. That sounds like enough but 2 of them often work on Sundays. One is on other rotas as well and can usually only cover one slot if that, and one is away a lot for family reasons and holidays.

#### Projection

We became one short on projection when one of our young lads left to go to uni. We managed to recruit one guy who is not quite ready to fly solo. Recently another projectionist has told me that he wishes to stop doing tech as soon as possible. We therefore need at least one, preferably 2 more people for projection. This is the most pressing need.

#### **Cameras**

We have 3 people who only do cameras, all of whom are on other rotas as well. I always need to use at least one of the sound team to cover cameras. We need another person for cameras ideally.

Please give this matter prayerful consideration and contact Doug or Vanessa Howard if you require further information. Full training is provided, including working with one of the existing team before going it alone!

# Seeing Christ in the Book of Proverss with the Help of Tim Keller

Part 5 'How to really Know God thru Godly fear'

Having looked at introductory lessons from the Book of Proverbs in previous articles, we now come to some of the specific teaching to be found there. In it, and the rest of the Bible, there are many references to the effect that 'The fear of the Lord is the beginning and continuation of wisdom'. What does that mean in practice?



1. We must begin with God in our mindset. 'In the beginning God

....'(Gen.1:1). We must keep God central to our lives if we want to keep in touch with reality and be wise. 'Love the Lord your God with all your soul .... This is the great and first commandment.'

- 2. Learn to 'fear God' as the Bible means that term, not by being scared of Him, but in joyful awe, wonder and humility. The word is linked to love and forgiveness in scripture (eg Deut.10:12, Ps.130:4). Psychologists tell us that what we most fear is what we most desire; so if what we most fear is to displease God, we show how much we love Him. The test of our love of Him is not head knowledge but how much we know Him personally and experientially, i.e. when spiritual truths become more real to us than physical things as many Godly people have attested in their journals.
- 3. The 'fear of the Lord' means to trust Him unconditionally with no 'ifs' to modify our discipleship/relationship with Him. As one Godly lady put it, "Can you imagine the God who made the universe just being regarded as your assistant?"
- 4. If realising this is our aim as Christians how do we get to that point of trust? Proverbs hints at an answer in its middle section. "Who can say, 'I have kept my heart pure; I am clean and without sin'" (Prov.20:9). "Through love and faithfulness sin is atoned for; through the fear of the Lord evil is avoided." (Prov. 16:6). We must realise our sinfulness before God and **our need for steadfast love/trust to bring us close to Him**. This was fulfilled in the NT in a real concrete example of love WHEN Jesus took our sins on the cross and obeyed God to be our sin offering, trusting implicitly in His ability to rescue Him.

"He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him," (Matt.27:43) said the religious leaders, and God honoured that trust as He will do for all who follow Jesus' example and put all their confidence in Him.

5. One final bit of advice; this trust is not a once for all experience but something, as Christians, we work at daily to grow into in our different situations. Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed - not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence - continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling', Phil.2:12


