The Runaway Prophet – Jonah 1:1-4

Last week we began a new series, with an overview of the book of Jonah. This week we're looking at the surprising opening words. Jonah was sent where no other Old Testament prophet was sent; he responded as no other Old Testament prophet responded. Tarshish, it is believed, was on the Atlantic coast of Southern Spain. It was as far away as it was possible to go from where God had sent him.



Jonah had a call that he refused to obey. He had a place to

go, a people to preach to, and a message to proclaim. His rebellion surprises us until we consider our own. We also have a place to go, a people to preach to, and a message to proclaim. How are we getting on with that?

Are we accepting God's call on our lives or are we also heading in a different direction? If we are, the only hope we have is that the God of Jonah will be as patient and persevering with us as he was with the runaway prophet.

Prayer Diary 6TH – 12TH May

All scripture is God breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work. 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Monday When we view the world through social media it often seems as though God is far away, and people are lovers of themselves. In your prayers today think about how Christians can send a positive message to others on this ever-growing platform. Think about how our children and young people are influenced by what they see and hear, and how we as Christians can guide them to help them make wise choices.

Tuesday Bring to God in your prayers the cries of the hungry, for those who are in Gaza, the Ukraine, Nigeria, Sudan and Democratic Republic of the Congo. Pray that food and medical aid might reach those in need. Think about closer to home where many families face food insecurity.

Wednesday Lamentations 3:22-23 Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning, great is Your faithfulness. Bring to God those who are recovering from addictions, where shattered lives need new beginnings. God can soften even the toughest heart. Pray that those who cry out to Him will have their needs met and will grow in God's love where He has planted them.

Thursday Psalm 147:3 He heals the broken hearted and binds up their wounds. Bring to God in your prayers those who are mourning the loss of a loved one, that they might find God's comfort and peace.

Friday Philippians 4:11-12. I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. Let us be content and not rush after the materialistic desires of this world. Pray that God will enable us to be bold and brave and set a Godly example.

Saturday Psalm 55:22 Cast your cares on the Lord, and He will sustain you. He will never let the righteous be shaken. With God's help we can rise above our problems. Pray that God can sustain you, and your friends and families, as you face challenges big and small.
