Some people have asked for clarification on this initiative which we are supporting Eastbourne Social Services with this year. The scheme is aimed at youngsters (16-25) who are leaving the council care system for whatever reason.

- Take one and buy the gift as indicated
- Wrap the gift, attach the tag, as you would any other Christmas present, and place it in the box beside the tree

Do look out for our latest gadget/device (see the pictures above), prominently situated by the wall-mounted TV in the Welcome Centre.

We now have a card reader for all of you to use to save you the hassle of remembering to bring cash if you want to make a donation. The device is very easy to use - the only thing to remember is that if you are eligible for Gift Aid, the first time

you use it may take up to a minute or so. This is because you will be asked for your first name, surname.

house number and postcode, and e-mail address. Once these details have been entered, they are retained by the system and future transactions should take a maximum of 20 seconds or so.

Do feel free to have a play with the device - it could become quite a habit for you - or that's what we hope!



GIFT Day

The total amount donated for our recent Gift Day was £67,346 so a huge thank you to all of you who made a contribution.

We will be able to claim back from the government, through the Gift Aid scheme, a further £13,869 making a grand total eventually of just over £81,000!

Praise God for His tremendous provision to us!

On the subject of Gift Aid, as you can see from these figures, Gift Aiding makes a big difference - so could I ask all of you who do give regularly, and are indeed eligible to claim Gift Aid, that you do give some prayerful consideration to signing up? We have a form that simply needs your signature! We will then be able to claim from HMRC 25% of whatever you give - and we can backdate the claim too, for 4 years - at no extra cost to yourselves!

These were put together in a booklet - "Delight in the Lord" - some 30 years ago by


Margaret Barham.
