






## **CHURCH Centenary Service**



# Prayer Diary: 9<sup>TH</sup> - 15<sup>TH</sup> June

"May He strengthen your hearts so that you will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God and Father when our Lord Jesus Christ comes with all His angels." 1 Thess 3:13

**Monday** Give thanks to God for our 100 years celebrations. Pray that having spent fun time together, and with God, this will bring increased unity, sense of purpose and enthusiasm for the gospel. Pray for any friends and family who attended the church over the weekend, that they be moved by God's spirit.

**Tuesday** Father, we pray that You will strengthen and increase the number of Christian MP's and local councillors in our country and enable those in positions of senior authority to be guided to serve Your purposes.

**Wednesday** Christians are persecuted throughout the world. Today, please focus on SW Asia praying for - Pakistan where Christians are often effectively modern slaves, isolated and struggling with their faith; Iran, where Christians are often imprisoned with hardship and harassment from government for their families; Saudi Arabia, trying to embrace a more progressive form of Islam to bring about the ending of honour murders in families and allowing believers to follow Jesus freely; Yemen, that the Holy Spirit will work miracles that will strengthen secret believers and that the church will continue to grow.

**Thursday** We pray that Your people of Israel will have their eyes opened to acknowledge that Jesus is their King and that this terrible war in Gaza will end. We also pray that the people of Gaza will turn to Christ and be saved.

**Friday** Apparently, more Amazon rain forest than ever has been destroyed this year, along with all the other environmental issues this is a cause of stress and anxiety to many, especially our young people. Father God, we pray that You will intervene to bring about change in worldwide government policies sooner and bring healing to Your beautiful planet and all creation.

**Saturday** Please pray for our staff team at VBC who are serving God to ensure that we are saved and that we grow in our faith. Lord, we pray for opportunities to encourage them and support them. We know that Satan will take any opportunity to knock them down and make their lives difficult through our harsh words or unhelpful actions. We pray that we, as a congregation, will bring joy to our leaders as they see You working among us through faith.

**Sunday** Paul's letters in 1&2 Thessalonians show how much he cares for this young church struggling with trials, confusion, division and suffering. He tells them that it is only Jesus who can help Christians to love each other. Let us humbly acknowledge that nothing will be achieved in our own strength and pray the words of 1 Thessalonians 3:13 "May the Lord strengthen our hearts so that we will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God and Father when lesus returns" Amen.
