- 3. Why do you think we have such a strong tendency to turn Jesus into our servant (please get me...) rather than our master?
- 4. A long time ago a man called Tertullian said "Just as Jesus was crucified between two criminals so the gospel is ever crucified between two errors". Legalism is one error, what is the other?
- 5. Which of the errors does your own heart lean towards and which do you think is most prominent in the church (at large) today?
- 6. Was there anything in this sermon that you hadn't heard or thought of before?
- 7. Explain in your own words what you think Martin Luther meant when he said: "Salvation is by faith alone but the faith that saves is never alone."
